

## Job Summary

The Clubhouse Manager is responsible for all aspects of club wide Food & Beverage operations, including A La Carte dining, member events, Seasonal Cafe and banquet operations throughout all outlets on the property. The Clubhouse Manager oversees all dining areas to ensure a smooth and consistent experience of service standards, high levels of member and guest satisfaction, quality food offerings, and exemplary service in conjunction with F&B staff and the Executive Chef. He/she exhibits a hands-on approach and understanding that full on-the-floor member and staff engagement is an essential component of this position. The Clubhouse Manager leads the enhancement of the club-wide service culture and the development of the member experience across the club. He/she will have a highly visible presence with the membership and must be a strong communicator and leader.

## Job Tasks

- Maintains contact with members and helps to assure maximum member satisfaction, while answering questions, addressing issues, solving problems and overseeing services.
- Book, plan and execute all Private Parties and Member events
- Handle all billing for Member and Private Events
- Using Clubessentials POS to create, and set up Sales items, while running usage reports.
- Monitors the budget and directs corrective action procedures as necessary to help assure that budget goals are attained.
- Runs a la carte service in absence of Dining Room Manager.
- Work with the Dining Room Manager to recruit, hire, train, and mentor employees.
- Plans and coordinates training and professional development programs for himself or herself and club personnel.
- Monitors safety conditions and employees' conformance with safety procedures; updates emergency plans and procedures and assures that effective training for these programs is conducted in all departments.
- Participates in on-going facility inspections along with GM and maintenance director throughout the club to assure that cleanliness, maintenance, safety and other standards are attained.
- Collaborate with Club committees to develop and evaluate innovative member programing of all areas of the club, including member events, and junior activities.
- Handles and documents employee grievances while informing the General Manager.
- Works with GM to develop long-term staffing needs for the clubhouse department.
- Ensures that all legal requirements are consistently followed.
- May perform clubhouse opening and closing duties.
- Completes other appropriate assignments made by the general manager
