#### WHO IS IT FOR?

Based on merit and financial need, it is for anyone pursuing through an accredited educational program, a career in the private club or hospitality industry and is presently employed part time, full time, or seasonally by a private club within the State of Connecticut.

#### AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Association will award at least one scholarship each year. The amount of the scholarship will depend on the financial condition of the CCMA. A recipient may reapply in subsequent years.

#### CRITERIA

Candidates should show evidence of an interest in the private club or hospitality industry and must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5.

#### HOW TO APPLY

Fill out the attached application form completely and include the following:

- An essay of no more than 500 words telling us about your interest in Club Management.
- A copy of your most recent grades from college or high school.
- A letter of recommendation from a Connecticut Club Manager and any other references you may wish to attach.
