Duties and Expectations

- Purchases pool chemicals and maintains inventory.
- Purchases pool supplies and maintains inventory.
- Responsible for the daily maintenance of the pool and pool area, which includes water clarity and cleanliness throughout the pool facility. Attention to detail.
- Assists in pool opening and closing at the beginning and end of the season.
- Interacts with pool service provider in maintaining pool and pool equipment.
- Knowledgeable with Westchester County Department of Health and State pool regulations.
- Responsible for member and guest daily registration at the pool.
- Responsible for charging members for guests, lessons, etc.
- Enforces club rules of safety and conduct.
- Knowledge of and ability to perform personal role in emergency situations.
- Certified Pool/Spa Operator (CPO)
- The Aquatic Facility Operator (AFO) Desirable
- Must have or pursuing American Red Cross Basic First Aid required, training on AED units and current Red Cross CPR card.
- Oversight of the Club's swim teams.
- Works with the Club's Camp Director to coordinate staffing and safety during camp.
- Weekends are a must.
