WHO IS IT FOR?

Based on merit and need, it is for anyone pursuing, through an accredited educational program (you must be a student), a career in the private club or hospitality industry and is presently employed part time, full time, or seasonally by a private club within the State of Connecticut.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Association will award at least one scholarship each year. The amount of the scholarship will depend on the financial condition of the Chapter. A recipient may re-apply in subsequent years.

CRITERIA

Candidates should show evidence of an interest in the private club or hospitality industry and must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5.
